Teresa De Gennaro is a University trained actor/singer from South Australia who graduated in 2000. Within the past seven years Teresa has worked professionally in a range of mediums and genres. From a Television Drama Soap, Comedy skit series to commercials, short and feature films, corporate video and voiceovers. Stage wise she has juggled straight theatre, live improvisational comedy, physical and children's theatre including musical theatre and Cabaret.

Receiving an acting scholarship within her first year of graduation, helped pave the way to working professionally with in the Entertainment Industry. Some of Australia's most reputable theatrical and television companies can now be credited to Teresa's CV: Playbox, Vitalstatistix, Windmill Performing Arts, The Adelaide Festival Centre Trust, Grayboy Productions, Skeed Entertainment, Millenium Ent., Banksia Productions, SBS and Channel 9.

Teresa's second scholarship helped boost her development as a Cabaret Artist. She has written many shows and visited Sydney's major Cabaret Venues including The Basement, various corporate functions and club circuit venues. Teresa has also performed at the Sydney Cabaret Festival and at the Adelaide Cabaret Festival, where she faced two consecutive years of sold out performances. Her latest creation involves singing in 20 different languages hailing divas of the world.

Throughout her time in Australia Teresa was also an acting, singing/vocal tutor in youth theatres, schools, casting agencies, Universities and the National Institute of Dramatic Art.

Sure enough Teresa took to exploring overseas. Having also Italian citizenship, she made Rome her base. She toured Southern Italy with her Cabaret, was seen on Channel RAI Uno's 'Le Sorelle McLeod' as an actress and worked at Face On Casting agency. She also discovered Florence and Denmark with innovative 'Sensorial' theatre companies such as 'Arcadia Arts,' 'Caballo Blanco' and Carte Blanche. Teresa has also worked as a production vocalist and cabaret artist cruising throughout the South Pacific and East Mediterranean.

Most recently Teresa has relocated to London. She has since featured in a Feature Film and a Short. She has toured as the lead in a pantomime and is to support 'The Barron Knights' with a cabaret set. Teresa has also begun singing in the corporate arena for Stuart Wood productions.
